A note from Guy Manning: "When I was at the 'Summers End' festival last year, I stayed at a hotel in Bilston, West Midlands. On the way from the hotel to the gig, I passed an old abandoned double fronted house with the windows all boarded up and the words 'Do Not Enter Here! The Last Person Died' painted in red on both bay windows. I think I knew then, as I asked myself just what had gone on in there, that there was an album to be made. Each song is set within a location in the house. There is no real mystery, no murder or menace, these are simply tales set within the boundary of one particular place over many years".
